UNIFORM FOR NURSERY TO STD VIII

For Boys: Grey trousers & Cream shirt.

For Girls: Grey skirt & cream shirt and white hair band. Grey belt with a White line, dark Grey socks with a White band and black shoes are common for both boys and girls.

WEDNESDAY {P.T} UNIFORM

For Boys: White shirt and white trousers.

For Girls: White shirt and White skirt and a red hair band. White socks with red strips, Red lined tie and belt and White canvas shoes are common for both boys and girls.

SATURDAY UNIFORM

For Boys T- shirt House colour with school pattern and

Black track suit.

Black track suit and a Red hair band.

White socks with red strips and White canvas shoes are common for both boys and girls.

Only Grayish Coloured Sweaters are allowed

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

No leave of absence is granted except on previous written application from parents or guardians and that too, only for serious reasons which should be mentioned.

In case of illness, a leave application with medical certificate should be sent on the 1st day of absence. Absence without leave for one continuous period of 15 days will lead to the removal of the student from the school.

Repeated absence for more than fifteen consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission if granted will be done on payment of re-admission fee.

No student who has been absent from school or is late to the school will be admitted to class without a signature in his/her diary.

WITHDRAWALS

Fifteen day's notice is required before a student can be withdrawn from the school.

However all the dues to the school shall be settled before issuing the Leaving Certificate. Application for leaving certificate shall be made in written by the parents / guardians.

ADMISSION

- 1.Registration for admission to the Nursery and K G I is generally done in the month of March.
- 2.Children who complete 3 years in the month of June are eligible for admission to Junior KG. Guardians seeking admission to KG section & Std
- 1 have to produce the true copy of the Birth certificate, Adhar Card & a passport size photo of their wards.
- 3.Admission to all the other classes will be done in the month of April depending on the availability of seats and on merit basis. Special consideration will be given to talented students in Sports, Games, and Cultural and Literary activities.
- 4.Once the admission is taken for any class, and if anybody withdraws the admission, the admission fee paid for the admission by the parents or guardians will not be refunded.

DISMISSAL

Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience or defiance of authority, malpractice in connection with examinations, lack of sufficient improvement in conduct and studies even after warnings or conduct injurious to the moral tone of the school are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student. A student who fails more than once in the same class

shall be removed from the rolls. The decision of the Principal shall be final in this matter.

EXAMINATIONS AND PROMOTION

The examination schedule 2024-2025 for classes I to X is divided into 2 Class tests of 10 marks each, 2 Unit Tests of 40 marks each and 2 Terminal exams of 80 marks each. According to the CBSE revised examination pattern 20 marks internal assessment Is divided Into 10Marks Periodic, Tests, 5 Marks for Note books and 5 Marks for Subject enhancement activities. The Class Test I, Unit Test I, and First Terminal exam will be included in the Term I result for classes I- IX and Class Test II Unit Test II, and Second Term will be included in the Term II result for classes I-IX. Students are mandatory to pass in both the Terms Individually. A student who seek dishonest aid in an examination will be disqualified from the rest of the examination, and more drastic step, explicitly dismissal may be taken by the Principal. A student who has not remitted his/her fees may be debarred from any examination.

Progress reports are issued to the students at the conclusion of Unit Tests and Terminal Examinations.

THERE WILL BE NO REEXAMINATION AT ANY TIME FOR ANY CAUSE, EXCEPT WHEN A STUDENT IS REQUIRED TO REPRESENT THE SCHOOL IN SOME ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE.

FEES

The school collects Tuition fee for 10 months only. It can be paid at a time or in a term, i.e. July. October, and January. It is payable during the first 15 days of those months or, the next working day, if the 15th happens to be a holiday. The students will not be allowed to sit for any exam unless the fees are paid fully. A fine of Rs. 50/- is charged after that date till the end of the month.

Term Fee and other relevant fees are collected every year. The computer fee for class first onwards, will be collected separately in the second & third installments. As the school meets all the expenses on its own, it reserves the right to increase the fees of the students slightly every year till it is in a position to pay the teacher's salary at par with the government norms of salary to teachers.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school has different kinds of co-curricular activities aimed at the harmonious development of the children. Students are exhorted to participate in these activities whole heartedly.

The following are the some of the co-curricular activities of the School: Literary club, Maths and Science Club, Sports Club, Arts Club, Quiz Contest, Public Speaking, Spell Bee, Spoken English, Music, Dance, Eco Club, Drawing and painting, Competitive Exams etc.

ATTENDANCE

- 1. Every day attendance is marked in the morning before the class teacher Starts teaching. 90% of the attendance is necessary for promotion.
- 2. Leave of absence up to maximum 6 days only will be granted by the Principal ON A PRIOR WRITTEN APPLICATION AND FOR SERIOUS REASONS ONLY. Parents taking their children away for marriages, festivals, holidays etc. without prior permission of the Principal are acting against the school regulations and are liable for disciplinary action.
- 3. The students are not allowed to be absent on the closing day, reopening day, or whenever there is a school function. In case of substantial reasons prior notice is a must.
- 4. If a student is absent on account of illness, he/she must bring a letter from his/her parents/gardian. For illness of more than 3 days the letter must be supported by medical certificate.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Physical Education is compulsory for all students. No pupil will be exempted from physical exercise or games unless it is specially permitted by the Principal.

HOUSE SYSTEM

This is an age for the 'fittest' and hence, healthy competitions have become the keyword of success. So the students are divided into different houses. Each house has a captain, a vice captain and a few teacher animators. House wise competitions are conducted to create a sense of belongingness and to make them feel the spirit of working together. Results of all such competitions are graded and recorded. Each house is given a house notice board to exhibit their talents in literary fields.

LIBRARY

- The school has a well-stocked Library consisting of books and periodicals In all subjects.
- The school library is open to all bonafide students of the school. All classes are provided with at least one library period per week.
- All should see that an atmosphere of silence and seriousness is observed in the library and the Computer Lab at all times.
- Books from the school Library will be Issued to students only during the library period allotted for each class.
- Books for reference can be obtained from the Library during the library hours.
- These books cannot be taken out of the library. Periodicals and new, papers should not be taken out of the reading room.
- All books, before they are taken out of the library, must be entered in the library issue register.
- Books are issued for the use only of the borrower hence he/ she may no, exchange them with or lend them to others.
- Books must be examined by the borrowers before they leave the library and they must point out to the librarian about the damages observed or else they will be held responsible for all damages found in the book while in their possession.
- Books may not be kept for more than a week. They may however be extended for another week, provided the book is overdue.
- In case of damage or loss of the book, the student will have to make good the loss or damage as assessed by the librarian.
- All library books must be returned one week before the Terminal or Final Examination, failing which a student may be debarred from the examination.

HOME STUDY AND PARENTAL CO-OPERATION

Parents /guardians are requested to go through the planner carefully and make a study of the rules and regulations. The school planner, part of the calendar contains pages to note down the homework, which the students are expected to do at home. Children should do their home-work by themselves. They should not be helped in their homework by parents or by tutors, unless they really need it. It is important that the children develop a habit of study and work on their own. Parents / guardians are informed that the reports and messages sent by teacher in the calendar should be read and signed

Parents should see that the children prepare their lessons regularly. They are requested to go through the answer sheets of all tests and examinations and sign them. If the child does not show the answer scripts they are requested to contact the principal.

"Self confidence is the most attractive quality on but you must have the ability to recognize it.

Parents are reminded that engaging private tutors for their children may prove injurious to their progress in studies. Parents should check all the books of the children periodically and make sure that the written work in all subject is up to date.

Criticism of a teacher should be avoided in the presence of the child because it undermines his/her respect for the teacher. If you have a legitimate compliant, please bring it to the notice of the Principal. Any such complaint made to her will be most welcome, as this could help in the better functioning of the school.

Parents should see that their children put in adequate hours of study at home. Apart from taking helpful interest in the academic work of the school, parents must also encourage their children to take part in all activities organized for the benefit of the children.

Parents, guardians and others may not meet students or their teachers during the school hours without the sanction of the Principal. On every saturday except Second Saturdays, they can meet the teacher between 12:15 pm to 12:45 pm

Parents / guardians should make it a point to visit the school and meet the principal at least once in a month to enquire about the progress of their children.

parents are requested to pay special attention to the personal cleanliness of their child, especially the child neatly attends the school in the prescribed uniform.

As the medium of instruction in the school is English, children should be helped to follow their class easily and intelligently by a certain amount of regular English conversation even at home.

If a child is absent without valid permission for more than 15 days, his/her name will be removed from the rolls. However, he/she may be readmitted provided the seat is still vacant by paying the re-admission fee.

DISCIPLINE

Discipline is an integral part of the learning process. If a student is to develop self-control he/she must be trained to bridle his/her emotions and impulses, thereby enabling him/her to live in harmony with other, to respect the traditions of his/her family, to keep the laws of the country and to obey the commandments of God.

All the students shall make themselves acquainted with the rules and regulations notified for their conduct. Ignorance of the rules will not be accepted as an excuse for their violation.

Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is not allowed. When passing along the corridors during class hours, students shall keep silence.

Classroom is a sacred place. Strict discipline is expected in the class. During the absence of a teacher the monitor should maintain the discipline in the class.

The students must obey them. The second monitor should report the matter to the principal within five minutes.

Students shall be responsible for the safe custody of their belongings. The school authorities will not be responsible for the loss of articles of students and for any injury or loss of life that might happen accidently. Any damaged caused to the property of the school must be immediately reported to the principal and will have to be made good by the concerned Child.

Speaking English Is compulsory at the school and In the premises.

Discourtesy and disrespect to the members of the school in any form will be viewed seriously and students responsible for such misbehavior are liable to be dismissed.

Genuine respect, love and gratitude to teachers, parents and school mates is expected from everyone. So pupil should greet their teachers whenever they meet them. They should also greet one another.

Politeness and courtesy in speech and conduct as well as cleanliness and grace of person are to be cherished.

The school insists on punctuality, regularity in attendance, cleanliness in dress, neatness in character and fidelity in study. Classrooms and surroundings should be kept neat and clean. Text books and note books should bring regularly to the class as per the time table. These books should be neatly covered and labeled.

Students suffering from contagious or infectious diseases will not be permitted to attend school.

TRANSPORT FACILITIES

School doesn't have bus facility. It provides transport facilities on certain routes through Bus / Sumo Contractors. Details in this regard can be obtained from the school office. School gate will be closed sharp at 7:55 am. School will not entertain or be responsible for the students coming late to School.

NEEDS FOR PARENTS <--> TEACHERS CO-OPERATION

The school needs co-operation of the guardians to get maximum information about their wards and their progress in order to have fuller understanding of his/her nature, talents, habits, environmental influence etc. Parents/Guardians are requested to visit the school on any working day at least once in a month between 2.00-2.30 noon and the staff will be glad to discuss with them about the character and progress of their children. But they may not enter into the class or interrupt the teachers during class hours. No students will be sent home unless an authorized person comes to

them with a letter of authority from parents. parents are requested to collect their wards before 2.30 PM from the school. It is advisable to have a home time table for the children for studies, play etc.

COMPLAINT ABOUT THE STUDENTS

We have categorized some of the most common faults under ten counts Kindly check the remarks of the teacher

- 1. Your ward did not do the homework given.
- 2. Your ward did not bring the text books, note books required in the class.
- 3. Your ward came to school wearing an untidy uniform.
- 4. Your ward came to school without wearing proper uniform.
- 5. Your ward came absent from school and leave letter was not given.
- 6. Your ward is irregular/late.
- 7. Your ward's report card is not signed.
- 8. Your ward's behaviour in the school was not satisfactory.
- 9. Your ward was disrespectful to the teacher.
- 10. Your ward is not showing any progress in studies.

GUIDELINES FOR FIRE PRECAUTIONS

Aims of fire drill: a. To prevent panic and ensure safe, orderly and efficient vacuation of all the occupants in case of a fire emergency. b. To get students and staff attuned to react rationally when confronted with a fire or other emergencies within the premises.

PROCEDURE DURING FIRE DRILLS/OUTBREAK OF FIRE:

- 1. Sound of alarm. Fire in predetermined part of the school will trigger the fire alarm. In a real emergency a loud hailer will be used if there is a power failure.
- 2. Evacuation of the premises. When the alarm sounds, all students must evacuate the premises immediately in a calm and orderly manner, making use of all available exits. If a specific staircase is cut off or rendered unusable by smoke or fire, use an alternative staircase.
- 3. Order of classes will movement:
- a. Each class to line up in twos.
- b. The classes will move off in an orderly fashion according to the emergency evacuation plan.
- c. All occupants will proceed to predetermined assembly point on open grounds, away from the building.
- d. At the assembly, a complete roll call will be carried out.

Any pupil who cannot be accounted for must be reported at once to the principal with his/her last known whereabouts in the building.

e, The person in charge will give the all-clear signals for re- entry into the buildings.

- 4. What to do it you discover a fire?
- a. Raise alarm immediately.
- b. Extinguish the fire by using the nearest fire fighting equipments, but not take unnecessary risks.
- c. Notify the principal or teachers of the fire.
- d. Evacuate the premises by using the nearest safest exit.

HINTS ON FIRE SAFETY: Be familiar with the location of exits. Where there is smoke, stay low, as the air is fresher there. Refrain from fighting a fire alone. Evacuate and proceed to the designated assembly point.

- Take corrections from your parents / teachers in a grateful and cheerful manner. It is meant for your own good.
- Observe good manners and etiquettes everywhere.
- Avoid vulgarity in talk and behaviour. Never call anybody bad names.
- Do not be noisy and quarrelsome. Be cheerful and polite.
- Lend a helping hand to everybody with a cheerful heart.
- Do your daily lessons. Do not leave everything until the time of examination.
- Never neglect the lessons or home work assigned to you.
- Draw up a study time-table with the help of your teacher or parents for your home study and be faithful to it.
- Never waste time. Time is precious. Make use of it sincerely.
- Inculcate in yourself civic responsibilities and try to fulfill as many as possible.
- Grow up to be a proud citizen of this country.

- Always encourage your children. Don't discourage them.
- Take time to listen.
- Set the right example.
- Develop a family sense of humour.

- Let the children share in your family duties.
- Be a friend to their friends.
- Provide wholesome sex instruction.
- Guide your children towards maturity.

- point out their civic responsibilities.
- Promote respect for authority.
- Assist them to make the most of free time.
- Provide them a zeal for learning.
- Elucidate their doubts.
- Instill the moral values in them.
- Help them to transparent in every field.
- Stimulate them to be creative.

यदि बच्चा 15 दिन से ज्यादा दिन तक लगातार अनूपस्थित रहेगा तो उसका नाम हाजिरी रजिस्टर से काट दिया जायेगा । फिर आपको कक्षा में दोबारा भर्ती कराने के लिये पूरी Admission फीस भरनी पडेगी ।

यदि आपको बच्चे की टी.सी (Transfer Certificate) चाहिये तो पहले आपको एक आवेदन पत्र पूर्ण हस्ताक्षर के साथ जमा करना होगा ।

- 2) बच्चे के प्रत्येक विशय में प्राप्त किये अंको के अनुसार ही उनको अगले कक्षा में प्रवेश दिया जायेगा

माता - पिता के लिये

यदि बच्चे होमवर्क (गृह-कार्य) नहीं कर रहे है या होमवर्क करने में असमर्थ है तो पहले मुख्याध्यापिका से संपर्क करे न कि कक्षा शिक्षिका से ।

माता-पिता को कक्षा में पढाई के समय कक्षाओं में जाना सख्त मना है । यदि माता-पिता को अपने बच्चों से मिलना है, तो उसके पहले मुख्याध्यापिका की अनुमति प्राप्त करें ।

यदि माता - पिता को शिक्षक / शिक्षिकाओं से मिलना हो तो उनके अवकाश समय पर ही मिले ।

स्कूल का माध्यम अंग्रेजी होने के कारण बच्चों से नियमित रूप से घर में भी अंग्रेजी में ही बातचित करें जिस्से की बच्चों को पढाई में आसानी हो सकें ।
